Policy Statement

No public asset should be privatised without good cause. Australia Post is owned by the people to serve the people.

Policy

The introduction of electronic technology, the internet, email, etc has lessened the demand for surface mail delivery services around the world.

Australia post is still however a major parcel delivery service and also provides valuable bill paying and other services.

Australia Post must remain in public ownership to ensure a fair and secure delivery system. National security must be paramount.

All communities must have access to Postal Service within their community as required under the Corporation Act 1989.

Agencies are only in remote locations when it is not practical to establish a Post Office.

Background Briefing

Member's concerns revealed the fact that they not only felt uncomfortable in handing their private mail to a private enterprise, but also the knowledge that they would be vulnerable to company policies.

Free enterprise responds to high profits. This may not provide an equitable service.
