- Upgrade age pensions.
- Implement quarterly indexation of pensions. Indexation on a “basket of goods” basis.

We need to look after the genuine cases, where people have fallen on hard times.

One Nation is intent on setting a time limit to unemployment payments.

Jobseekers are actively encouraged to attend training provided and/or to take a job offered, or face the prospect of losing all benefits.

Skills and experiences gained will provide better prospects of finding a more challenging job. This will also be the base from which to build self-worth and self-esteem.
